Materials Needed

Paper or card – the larger the better
scissors | pen | pencil | rubber | ruler | paints | paint brush | masking tape

Optional:

Preferred paints | coloured pencils | felts | crayons

What to do

We used an A3 sheet of paper folding the top part and cutting off to create a square sheet.

1. Draw your desired pattern in the centre of the paper, leaving roughly 4cm all the way around your design (photo A).
2. Fold your paper into quarters, then open it up and cut along both fold lines, keeping each piece in place.
3. Rotate each individual square, so the pattern faces outwards. The white space between the pattern roughly forms a cross shape (photo B).
4. Tape it all together on the reverse to keep it all in place.
5. Continue creating the pattern in the empty space until complete.
6. You now have a wallpaper effect with a design that can be repeated infinitely!
